Amendments to the KUSA/Zimbabwe Breed Standard Hound Group Rhodesian Ridgeback

To whom it may concern

I am writing to inform that the federal council, the supreme committee for standard requirements in South Africa, has decided and approved at the meeting of the Federal Council on 29 & 30th June 2019 on the following standard change:

Old:	New 01.01.2020
<u>FAULTS:</u> - Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree and its effect upon the health and welfare of the dog.	<u>FAULTS:</u> - Overly shy dogs - Incorrect crowns on ridge <u>DISQUALIFYING FAULTS:</u> - Aggressive behaviour - Dogs without ridge Any dog showing physical or behavioural abnormalities shall be disqualified.

The amendment to the standard will take effect on 01.01.2020.

The FCI will be informed about this change by the Kennel Union of Southern Africa (KUSA) to ensure that the lack of the ridge is a reason for disqualification in the future. This change of the standard by the country of origin makes it unambiguous that a so-called ridgeless Ridgeback variant is by no means desired.
